Notice of the Passing of a Zoning By-Law

Take Notice that the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Elgin passed By-Law No. 2026-06 on the 26th day of February 2026 under Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990.

The subject lands are legally described as Part Lot 3, Concession 2, and locally known at 23104 Johnston Line as shown on the key map on the back of this notice.

THE PURPOSE AND EFFECT of this By-law was to consider a zoning amendment as a condition of consent approval to rezone the retained farmland parcel from General Agricultural (A1) Zone to Agricultural (A2) Zone, in order to prohibit a dwelling; and rezoning the severed surplus farm dwelling parcel from General Agricultural (A1) Zone to Rural Residential (RR) Zone, in order to recognize the new surplus farm dwelling lot being created for residential use.

The Written and Oral Submissions are summarized in the Planning Report 2026-04 and in the Statutory Public Meeting portion of the Council Meeting minutes of February 26, 2026; and were considered as part of the effect on the decision-making process.

AND TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that any person or public body may appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal with respect to the By-law by filing with the Clerk of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Elgin, no later than the **19th day of March, 2026**, a notice of appeal setting out the objection to the by-law and the reasons in support of the objection, accompanied by the fee required by the Tribunal in the amount of \$1100.00 which must be in the form of a certified cheque, money order or credit card made payable to the Ministry of Finance and in Canadian funds. An Appellant may request a reduction of the filing fee to \$400, if the Appellant is a private citizen or eligible community group. The request for a reduction in the fee must be made at the time of filing the appeal. No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of the appeal unless, before the by-law was passed, the person or public body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the council or, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.
