

Garbage & Recycling Collection

Garbage Pickup Only

Note: Collection will take place on Holidays except December 25 No change to scheduled collection day

Garbage

- 1 Garbage must be curbside by 7 a.m. Collection takes place between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- 2 If reusable containers are used, the containers must be in good repair at have two handles on either side for easy dumping with the lid removed. West Elgin is not responsible for lost or damaged containers.
- 3 Bags and contents cannot weigh more than 44 lbs.
- 4 Clear and Black garbage bags are accepted.
- 5 Three (3) garbage bag limit. Excess garbage will not be taken

Recycling

- 1 Blue Boxes must be curbside by 7 a.m. Collection takes place between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- 2 Two Stream Recycling System Fibers and Container recyclables must be separated, NO Plastic Bags.
- 3 No limit on the amount of recyclables collected.
- 4 Each Blue Box and contents cannot weigh more than 44 lbs.
- 5 Break down, flatten and bundle your cardboard boxes or stack them flattened in your recycling bin.
- 6 Cardboard is not to exceed 24" x 24" x 8" in size.
- 7 Residents may use containers that are not issued by the municipality as long as they are easily identifiable as recyclables and meet all other guidelines. West Elgin will not replace containers thought to be garbage or recycling by Waste Connections. Containers may have drain holes.

Unacceptable For Curbside Pickup

- 1 Hazardous Waste (paint, oil, propane cylinders, etc.)
- 2 Appliances
- 3 Bio-Medical Waste
- 4 Combustible or Explosive Materials
- 5 Vehicle or Automobile parts
- 6 Construction Debris
- 7 Household Furniture
- 8 Crates and Pallets
- 9 Sharps (Syringes, Lancets)
- 10 Leaves and Garden material (except Special Collection day)

Household Hazardous Waste Depot

West Elgin residents may take hazardous waste to the St Thomas Community Recycling Centre located at 330 South Edgware Road, St Thomas.
