Large Item Curbside Collection - Week of May 9-13
 Have all items curbside by 7 am on Monday May 9 and they will be collected throughout the week - **NO SMALL ITEMS**

Items Accepted for Large Item Collection:
 furniture such as sofas, couches, desks chairs, tables, rugs, patio furniture, bed springs, mattresses, bed frames; Large fixtures such as bathtubs, toilets, sinks; other household items such as water softener tanks (all water and salt must be removed), bicycles; carpet rolls and under padding (materials must be rolled and bundled in lengths not to exceed four feet); any other large articles which would normally come from a household.

Items NOT Accepted for Large Item Collection:
 Large appliances such as stoves, microwaves, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, hot tubs; business, commercial, industrial, agricultural and construction material; medical waste; small items, loose refuse and other rubbish waste; construction/renovation materials including siding, doors, windows, lumber, concrete, stone; organic materials, tree stumps, leaves, branches; agricultural waste, crates, skids or farm machinery; hazardous waste; electronics; drums or fire barrels; power tools.



Garbage & Recycling Collection

- Garbage**
- Garbage must be curbside by 7 a.m. Collection takes place between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.
 - If reusable containers are used, the containers must be in good repair and have two handles on either side for easy dumping with the lid removed. West Elgin is not responsible for lost or damaged containers.
 - Bags and contents cannot weigh more than 44 lbs.
 - Clear and Black garbage bags are accepted.
 - Three (3) garbage bag limit.** Excess garbage will not be taken

- Recycling**
- Blue Boxes must be curbside by 7 a.m. Collection takes place between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.
 - Two Stream Recycling System - Fibers and Container recyclables must be separated, **NO Plastic Bags.**
 - No limit on the amount of recyclables collected.
 - Each Blue Box and contents cannot weigh more than 44 lbs.
 - Break down, flatten and bundle your cardboard boxes or stack them flattened in your recycling bin.
 - Cardboard is not to exceed 24" x 24" x 8" in size.
 - Residents may use containers that are not issued by the municipality as long as they are easily identifiable as recyclables and meet all other guidelines. West Elgin will **not** replace containers thought to be garbage or recycling by **Waste Connections**. Containers may have drain holes.

- Unacceptable For Curbside Pickup**
- Hazardous Waste (paint, oil, propane cylinders, etc.)
 - Appliances
 - Bio-Medical Waste
 - Combustible or Explosive Materials
 - Vehicle or Automobile parts
 - Construction Debris
 - Household Furniture
 - Crates and Pallets
 - Sharps (Syringes, Lancets)
 - Leaves and Garden material (except Special Collection day)

 West Elgin residents may take hazardous waste to the St Thomas Community Recycling Centre located at 330 South Edgware Road, St Thomas.
