

Council Highlights

January 23, 2020 Council Meeting

- Council received the Engineer's Reports for the Smith Drain and McColl Drain West, and authorized staff to initiate the tender process if required. Council also passed Provisional By-Laws for each.
- Council presented their decisions on the Community Grant Applications received at the Committee of the Whole meeting on January 16, 2020, Grants will be awarded once the budget is finalized.
- Council received a delegation from Mike Vanderloo regarding his petition to support a By-law to allow for ATV use on municipal roads. Mr. Vanderloo will return with more information at a future meeting.
- The Chief Building Official provided Council with a monthly building permit activity report for December 2019.
- Council received a report regarding user percentages at the West Elgin Arena, for information purposes.
- Council recommended approval for a severance at 11149 Blacks Road in Rodney.
- Council selected Bluffs Road as the name of the proposed private road as part of the proposed Lighthouse Condominium development.
- Council approved TekSavvy Solutions Inc. to increase the height of the telecommunications tower located at 10996 Furnival Road.
- Council approved the Apportionment of Drainage Assessment for the Hay Drain as part of a severance at 24381 Thomson Line in West Lorne as part of a Severance.
- Council appointed Courts of Revision for the Smith Drain and McColl Drain West.
- Council received a report from Human Resources Consultant R. Bryce regarding the Organizational and Operational Review of the Municipality of West Elgin. Council directed Mr. Bryce to present this report to Municipal staff and release the report to the public.

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
