

Council Highlights

January 2, 2020 – Special Council Meeting

- The 2020 Capital Budget was approved
- The 2020 Revised Operating Budget was presented. Council provided direction to Staff with regards to some changes they wish to see. The 2020 Operating Budget will return at a future meeting
- The Committee of Adjustment was appointed for 2020
- The 2020 Council Remuneration By-law was passed with an increase of 1.7%. •
- The 2020 Employee Remuneration By-law was passed with an increase of 1.7% for all employees.

January 9, 2020 Council Meeting

- A Public Meeting was held regarding a re-zoning for Lakeview Aldborough Bluffs Inc. for a property located at Concession 14, Parts of Lots 4 and 5. The zoning by-law amendment was passed during the Regular Meeting of Council.
- The Committee of Adjustment met regarding a Minor Variance at 13674 Furnival Road and the request was approved.
- Council received a monthly update from Public Works Superintendent regarding the department's activities in December. It was reported that Davey Trees are continuing work on Tree removal along municipal roads with staff assistance when required. Wet conditions made gravel road maintenance challenging and with the warmer weather grading will continue into the New Year weather permitting and that Operators have now started the cutting process on the phragmites that were sprayed in the fall.
- Council received a monthly update from the Recreation Superintendent. It was reported that the New Year's Eve Skate was attended by 60 skaters; the Recreation Committee is hosting a free family movie night on January 24th at the West Elgin Recreation Centre; Joe's Bush was inspected by staff and some tree removal work will be required; and that a 911 number will be installed at the entrance to Eagle Ponds Park.
- Council approved an application for severance at 26588 Carroll Line provided the conditions of severance are met.

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 - Council received a report regarding the Municipal Asset Management Program and directed staff to proceed with a revised application.
 - Council passed a By-Law to authorize the execution of an Agreement for the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program: Rural and Northern Stream (ICIP) Funding. This funding was received for improvements to Blacks Road north of the 401.
 - A by-law providing for a Zoning By-Law Amendment for Lighthouse Waterfronts Inc. was given a third and final reading, and finally passed.
 - Council directed staff to start posting warning notices on vehicles parked in the noparking areas.
