- Council held a public participation meeting in regard to a Site Plan Application for the development of 22 townhouse units at 196 Ridge St. A resolution was passed to execute the agreement.
- Council held a public participation meeting in regard to a Site Plan Application for the development of a new restaurant with a drive-thru at 244 Graham Rd. A resolution was passed to execute the agreement.
- Council received the Q3 Reports from S. Smith of OCWA for Water Distribution, and the West Lorne and Rodney Wastewater Treatment Plants.
