

December 17, 2020 Council Meeting

- Council held a public meeting to review an application for proposed amendment to Comprehensive Zoning By-Law 2015-36 for 26591 Downie Line and approved the rezoning.
- Council received an update regarding the Staff Health and Safety Committee.
- Council approve the purchase of services from OSG to coordinate Health and Safety duties and obligations.
- Council received a monthly report from the Fire Chief.
- Council approved the continuation of West Elgin's Tree Giveaway Program for spring 2021.
- Council directed staff to not renew the Blue Flag Beach accreditation for Port Glasgow Public Beach.
- Council approved the elimination of sewage charges on municipal water which is metered separately and used for industrial boiler systems, effective immediately.
- Council directed that the cost of purchasing equipment required for broadcasting Council meetings be brought forward as part of the 2021 Budget deliberations.
- Council reviewed the options for water and sewage flat rate reductions for multi-residential properties and at this time chose to maintain status quo.
- Council received a report from CAO/Treasurer that outlined the projects completed in 2020.
- Council approved the extension of external audit services for a three (3) year period of 2021-2025 to engage Scrimgeour & Company Chartered Accountant.
- Council approved the request to prepare a Request for Proposal for the Municipal Office Renovation to be issued in early 2021.
- Council approved the 2021 Municipal Insurance Renewal for 2021 and directed staff to issue a request for quotes for 2022.
