- Council received a delegation from Michell Tynan regarding a proposed Nature School in West Elgin.
- Council received the monthly building permit report from CBO. At this time there is little impact from the new Emergency Restrictions on construction in West Elgin.
- Council received the monthly report from the Fire Chief, who acknowledged the work
  of Fire Fighters during the fatal fire in West Lorne in March.
- Council received the monthly report from Operations and Community Services.
- Council directed staff to negotiate an agreement with St Thomas Community Recycling Centre for residents to be able to transport their hazardous waste to their depot, as a replacement for the Annual Municipal Hazardous Waste Day, due to the removal provincial subsides as of June 30, 2021.
- Council directed staff to prepare a survey for residents on the options for voting in the 2022 Municipal and School Board Elections. This survey will be available on the website and included in the August mail out of the final tax bills.
- Council appointed Spriet & Associates as the Engineers to prepare a report for the requested relocation of the McKenzie Municipal Drain.
- Council approved the waiver of rental fees for Municipal Facilities for West Elgin Community Health Centre to host COVID-19 Vaccine Clinics once they are provided with the supply of vaccines.
