Council Highlights

April 8, 2021 Council Meeting

Due to Technical issues, no recording of this meeting is available.

- Council received the 2020 Landfill Monitoring Report from BluMetric. Currently its is projected that there is 20 years capacity left in the landfill.
- Council received a presentation from MPAC on the tax assessments for West Elgin.
- Council received a delegation with a proposal for a rehabilitation of the Rodney Lagoon from the West Elgin Nature Club.
- Council received a presentation from the County of Elgin regarding the representation on the OPP Police Services Board for Elgin County.
- Council received a delegation from Elgin County Library regarding a mural on the Rodney Library and approved in principle the idea of a mural, pending the presentation of an agreement.
- Council considered a request from Port Glasgow Yacht Club regarding a request to do maintenance at the Marina. The Municipality will draw up an agreement with the Yacht Club laying out the terms and conditions of the maintenance.
- Council received a report from the Fire Chief with regards to the proposals for awarded Fire Safety Grant.
- Council recommended approval with conditions to the County of Elgin for four severance applications for a property legally described at North Part Lot 6, Concession 7; Part Lots 2 and 11, Plan 202, located on Furnival Road between Downie Line and Centre Street.
- Council received a draft of a Site Plan Control Area By-law and provided comments to the Planner. The by-law will be circulated to area stakeholders and posted on the municipal website for public comments until April 30, 2021.
- Council approved L360 proposal to provide the design, development, construction and permit drawings required for the required municipal office renovations.
- Council supported the following resolutions from Owen Sound regarding Municipal Insurance Rates, Township of Pick Lake regarding amendments to the Elections Act and Municipality of Calvin regarding paid sick days.
- Council requested that staff report back to them on options and costs regarding backyard chickens.

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
