

## Council Highlights

- Council received a monthly report from the Chief Building Official, in June there were 16 Building Permits issued for total construction value year to date of \$4,583,225.00, which is up from 2020.
- Council received a monthly report from the Fire Chief, there were a total of 21 Emergency Responses for the month of June.
- Council directed the Fire Chief to enter into an agreement with Southwest Middlesex for automatic aid coverage for Beattie Manor.
- Council directed the Fire Chief to engage Bill Todd's fire inspection and investigations services and draft an agreement to provide fire inspections for West Elgin.
- Council received a monthly report from Manager of Operations & Community Services.
- Council received a report from the CAO/Treasurer and Clerk regarding Administrative Updates.
- Council received a year to date financial update from the CAO/Treasurer.
- Council approved the CAO/Treasurer to sign an agreement with Excellent Signs to produce two electronic signs at a cost of \$114,700 with a report to come in future detailing the specifications and recommended site specific designs.
- Councillor Rowe reported that the Four Counties Transportation Services Committee has increased the capacity of the Four Counties Bus to 8 passengers, with all other COVID-19 precautions still in place.
- Council supported a Chatham Kent resolution to support the induction of Coloured All-Stars into the Canadian Baseball Hall of Fame.
