

## Council Highlights

April 28, 2022 Council Meeting

- Council held a public participation meeting regarding the rezoning of 23304 Downie
  Line as a condition of Severance E37-21 by rezoning of the retained farmland parcel
  from General Agricultural (A1) Zone to Agricultural (A2) Zone, in order to prohibit a
  dwelling; and rezoning the severed surplus farm dwelling parcel from General
  Agricultural (A1) Zone to Restricted Agricultural (A3) Zone, in order to recognize the
  new surplus farm dwelling lot being created with restricted agricultural land use
  permissions. Council approved this rezoning.
- Council held a public participation meeting regarding the rezoning of 25597 Stalker
  Line as a condition of Severance E43-21, by rezoning of the retained farmland
  parcel from General Agricultural (A1) Zone to Agricultural (A2) Zone, in order to
  prohibit a dwelling; and rezoning the severed surplus farm dwelling parcel from
  General Agricultural (A1) Zone to Restricted Agricultural (A3) Zone, in order to
  recognize the new surplus farm dwelling lot being created with restricted agricultural
  land use permissions. Council approved this rezoning.
- Council held a public participation meeting regarding the rezoning of 20183 Marsh Line as a condition of Severance E67-21, by rezoning of the severed surplus farm dwelling parcel from General Agricultural (A1) Zone to Restricted Agricultural (A3) Zone, in order to recognize the new surplus farm dwelling lot being created with restricted agricultural land use permissions. The retained parcel will remain in the General Agricultural (A1) Zone, since it is to be amalgamated with the property to the west, also owned by the purchasing farmer. Council approved this rezoning.
- Council received a report on the year-to-date waiver of fees for municipal facilities.
