## Council Highlights

### February 10, 2022 Council Meeting

- Council held a public meeting to hear comments on a proposed zoning amendment for 711 Victoria Street, Rodney. This amendment to the Comprehensive Zoning By-law would permit the development of 18 unit residential apartment dwelling units and permit a reduction in side yard width. Council approved this amendment in the by-law portion of the agenda.
- Council awarded the following grants:
  - Tryconnell Heritage Society - \$1,000 for the 225 Anniversary of the Fleming Settlement
  - West Lorne Horticultural Society - \$1,000 for bedding plants and Waiver of Fees for Plant Sale
  - West Lorne Legion - \$3,000 for Washroom upgrades
  - West Lorne Optimist - \$2,000 for Mother's Day Road Race
  - West Elgin Community Health Centre – Waiver of Fees for Children's Fitness Program
- Council received monthly reports from Operations and Community Services and Administration.
- Council received the Pre-Election Accessibility Report from the Clerk
- Council re-appointed Deputy Mayor Richard Leatham to the Lower Thames Valley Conservation Authority Board.
- Council provided direction to staff to bring forward a by-law to adopt the draft Water Billing Policy and Procedures at a future Council meeting.
- Deputy Mayor Leatham requested that staff research options for dealing with the increased Coyote population in the area.
