- Council received a delegation from BlueMetric with regards to the Landfill Annual Report.
- Council recommended approval to the Elgin County Land Division Committee for Severance Application for 26661 Silver Clay Line
- Council approved the Service Agreement/Memorandum of Understanding for Land Use Planning Lower Thames Conservation Authority that the Fees related to Land Use Planning from the LTCA be implemented as of July 1, 2022.
- Council received the report regarding the West Lorne Sanitary Sewer Capacity
- Council supports staff's decision to eliminate Large Item Collection beginning in 2023 and replacing it with a Free Large Item week at the municipal landfill once in the Spring and once in the Fall.
- Council approved partnering with the County of Elgin and interested Local Municipal Partners in the Joint RFP to secure a new provider to fulfill the roles of Integrity Commissioner, Closed Meeting Investigator and Municipal Ombudsman
- Council received the Rodney Wastewater Treatment Plant Refurbishment Project report from the CAO/Treasurer and directs staff to transfer previously budgeted Lagoon Drudging fund toward mechanical upgrades in the amount of \$800,000. The Lagoon funds are to be covered by 2022 OCIF funding.
- Council approved a request for Noise Exemption for fireworks at 116 Angelo Dr., West Lorne on July 2 and August 20 with the condition that the fireworks cease by 10 pm and that all the neighbours be notified
