

## Council Highlights

February 24, 2022 Council Meeting

- Council held a public participation meeting for the rezoning of 21934 Johnston Line.
  Council approved the rezoning as part of Consent Application E68-21 from
  Agricultural (A1) Zone to Agricultural (A2) Zone and Restricted Agricultural Site-Specific Provision 6 (A3-6) Zone. The site specific provision reduces the minimum lot frontage.
- Council approved 1 voting member and 1 alternate (non-voting) member from the Youth Task Force be appointed to the West Elgin Recreation Committee.
- Council approved the new webpage developed by staff, dedicated to informing residents of the ability to add secondary or additional dwelling units to their properties.
- Council received a report on Coyote Population Control and requested staff provide information on the website about how to Coyote proof a property.
- Council approved the Use of Corporate Resources During an Election Policy.
- Council received the 2021 Council remuneration report from CAO/Treasurer. The information is to be posted on the municipal website prior to February 28 annually.
- Council supported a resolution to dissolve the Ontario Land Tribunal.
- Council approved the Rodney Shuffleboards and Carpet Bowlers request to waive the rental fees for 2022.
- Manager of Operations & Community Services reported that they have enough local groups and businesses willing to sponsor free public skating every day during the March Break School Holiday.

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
