

Council Highlights

August 13, 2020 Council Meeting

- Council held a public meeting for the Rezoning of 20662 Marsh Line. This rezoning is required as part of a severance application.
- Council received a delegation from Elgin, Middlesex, London MP Karen Vecchio. MP Vecchio to discuss the concerns and receive feedback on how the Municipality is fairing through the pandemic.
- Council received second guarter reports from OCWA relating to the operations of the West Elgin Water Distribution System, West Lorne Wastewater Treatment plant and Rodney Wastewater Treatment plant.
- Council approved additional funding for the refurbishment of the Memorial Carin at the Memorial Park in Port Glasgow
- Council received a monthly activity report from Operations and Community Services. The Arena will be open as of September 21, 2020, the pool will be running on reduced hours between August 31 to September 5. Blue bins have been delivered to rural residents and municipal wide collection has been going well. Construction has begun on the replacement of the cast iron watermain behind the Rodney library and completion work on Chestnut street in West Lorne has taken place.
- Council approved the concept of the Municipal Office renovations as presented by Elgin County Engineer and approved the completion of engineered drawings.
- Council approved a daft flag raising policy, with an approving by-law to be brought forward at the next Council meeting.
- Council approved the purchase of Asset Management Software to comply with Ontario Regulation 588/17.
- Council approved the proposal from RV Anderson for additional engineering services for the Port Glasgow Trailer Park sewage disposal system. The cost of this will be covered by the Port Glasgow Trailer Park Reserves.
- Council passed a resolution to support a Private Members Bill to recognize Emancipation Day Officially on August 1 of each year.
- Council passed a resolution to proclaim October 22, 2020 as Child Care Worker & Early Childhood Educator Appreciation Day.
- Council received correspondence from the Province of Ontario indicating that as part of the first round of Municipal Emergency Funding they will receive \$197,500.00.
