PUBLIC NOTICE – COUNCIL VACANCY

TAKE NOTICE that a vacancy exists on the Municipality of West Elgin Council for one (1) Councillor, Ward Three (3), and that Council has determined to fill this vacancy by appointment of applications, in accordance with Section 263 (1)(a) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*.

Pursuant to Section 264, the term of this position is for the duration of the 2022-2026 term of Council, ending November 14, 2026.

A candidate for municipal office must be a qualified municipal elector as set out in the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* and fulfill all of the following requirements:

- Eighteen (18) years of age or older; and
- A Canadian citizen; and
- A resident of the Municipality of West Elgin, or an owner or tenant of land in the municipality or the spouse of such an owner or tenant; and
- Not prohibited from voting under any other Act or disqualified from holding municipal office.

Prior to submitting an application, interested individuals should refer to the *Municipal Act, 2001* and the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* for further details relating to the required qualifications.

Any qualified individual may submit an Application Form, Declaration of Qualifications, and one (1) page (8.5x11) detailing your qualifications and objectives, and submit in person (no fax or email) with identification no later than Thursday, May 22, 2025, at 2:00 pm.
